PLEASE NOTE: GARBAGE, RECYCLABLES AND HEAVY METAL SHOULD BE PLACED

AT THE CURB SIDE AFTER 6:00 P.M. THE DAY PRIOR TO PICKUP.

PLEASE AVOID LEAVING TRASH OUT LONGER THAN NECESSARY

A Village of Silver Creek garbage bag must be attached to large items (couch, chairs, etc.);

This does not include heavy metal pickup.

Mattresses & Box Springs must be wrapped in plastic and have a Silver Creek bag attached.

Televisions and computer monitors will NOT be picked up. These items must be disposed of at a transfer station.

GARBAGE PICK UP EVERY THURSDAY (unless otherwise noted).

ONLY garbage placed in Silver Creek bags will be collected.

Heavy items that are likely to tear the bags should be placed in a garbage can lined with a Silver Creek bag.

Bags are available for \$1.25 each or \$12.50 for one roll (10 bags) at the Village Hall between 8:00A.M. and 4:00P.M.

Monday through Friday except on legal holidays.

Bags are also available at Tops Market and Save-A-Lot.

*Glass items such as mirrors, ceramics, light bulbs, window glass, drinking glasses, colored glass, etc. are to be put in regular household garbage. They are no longer counted as recyclables

RECYCLING: THURSDAY, ENTIRE VILLAGE (same schedule as garbage pickup)

Newspapers, magazines, catalogs and other shiny papers, such as inserts: Place in covered container, loose.

KEEP DRY. Do not place in paper or plastic bags.

Cardboard, corrugated ONLY: These items must be flattened with staples and tape removed. KEEP DRY.

*NOTE: Wax coated cardboard, cereal boxes; milk cartons, pizza boxes, etc. are regular household garbage.

Metal: Food and beverage cans only: Rinse clean. Remove ends and flatten.

*NOTE: Aerosol cans and EMPTY/CLEAN paint cans are to be put in regular garbage.

Soft plastic: Recycling code numbers 1&2. Plastic milk jugs are recyclable - They must be rinsed clean, flattened, and with lids, caps and rings removed.

HEAVY METAL: LAST WEDNESDAY OF EACH MONTH

(excluding December, January, February) Items included: large appliances, steel pipes, drain pipes, etc.

- *NOTE: appliances containing Freon (refrigerators, dehumidifiers, freezers, air conditioners) will not be picked up. Freon must be removed by a certified refrigeration person. A certificate will then be placed on the appliance and the Village will pick it up.

BRUSH: FIRST AND THIRD MONDAY OF EACH MONTH (excluding November through March)

Place at curb no more than 24 hours before pickup day.

- Cut brush, shrubs, and limbs four (4) feet or less in length and pile neatly at curb side with ends facing in the same direction. Place leaves, grass clippings and small sticks in containers (NO bags or boxes).

Containers must not weigh more than 40 lbs.

- In the FALL, when the Village announces leaf pick up by machine, leaves only should be piled at the curb.*

*NOTE: brush that has metal, paper, and garbage, building material or pet waste will NOT be picked up.

TREE REMOVAL: Contractor is responsible for all clean-up and disposal.
